

WELCOME TO ST STEPHEN WALBROOK



THE HISTORY OF ST STEPHEN WALBROOK



ROMAN TEMPLE

A temple of Mithras stood on the bank of the Walbrook, a stream which brought life to the area. Roman soldiers worshipped here and also built a series of baths.

• 2ND CENTURY - 410AD

MONASTERY EXPANSION

Eventually a monastery was built in around 1085AD, begun by the cupbearer to Henry I.

THE GREAT FIRE OF LONDON


The Great Fire of London began and within 24 hours, St Stephen Walbrook was burnt to the ground. Over three quarters of the City of London was destroyed and King Charles Il appointed a commission to plan rebuilding the City.

• 2ND SEPTEMBER 1666



BUILDING WORK BEGINS

St Stephen Walbrook began to be rebuilt, Wren's own parish church, he lived at No.15 Walbrook. It cost £7,672, a large amount of money at the time.

THE SAMARITANS

ON 2 NOVEMBER 1953 THE SAMARITANS

The Samaritans is founded at St Stephen Walbrook by a young vicar called Chad Varah. The first call to the new service was made on 2nd November 1953 and this date is recognised as Samaritans' official birthday. There are now over 200 branches across the UK and Republic of Ireland. The actual telephone is still on display at St Stephen Walbrook.

A NEW **COURTYARD**

Lanning Roper was commissioned to undertake the design of the courtyard behind St Stephen Walbrook.

A CHRISTIAN CHURCH

It was on this site that the first Christians built a church over the temple to eradicate the pagan site.

EXPANSION OF THE CHURCH

Due to the church and graveyard being too small for the parish, Robert Chicheley, a member of The Worshipful Company of Grocers gave land so a new church could be built approx. 20m to the east of the original location.



• 1669

ROYAL ARCHITECT APPOINTED

Sir Christopher Wren was appointed as the King's surveyor and Royal architect, commissioned to oversee the rebuilding programme.

WONDERFUL **WOODWORK**

William Newman designed and carved the wooden font and pulpit.

• 18TH CENTURY

THE PRIDE OF ENGLISH **ARCHITECTURE**

By the eighteenth century, the building was famous all over Europe. The Italian sculptor-architect, Canova, said he would gladly return to feast his eyes once more on St. Paul's Cathedral, Somerset House, and, most of all, St. Stephen Walbrook, saying 'we have nothing to touch it in Rome'. Sir John Sommerson described the Church as 'the pride of English architecture, and one of the few City churches in which the genius of Wren shines in full splendour'.



OVERVIEW OF THE VENUE





1. MAIN ENTRANCE & STAIRCASE

The main entrance of the church lies on Walbrook, a short walk from Bank tube station. For your event, the double doors will be open ready for you to welcome guests with the support of one of our professional and friendly security guards. Make an excellent first impression by adding a red carpet or lanterns and candles to the stone staircase.



4. PULPIT

The beautifully crafted wooden pulpit is frequently used by the priest for weekly sermons and can be used by your speaker for important speeches and announcements. A lectern mic is already installed making impromptu speeches easy to accommodate.



2. HENRY MOORE ALTAR

Located at the heart of the church and directly beneath Wren's magnificent domed ceiling lies a central circular altar. The altar was carved by Henry Moore from a single block of Travertine marble and installed in 1987. The bright and colourful kneelers were designed by Patrick Heron in 1993. For confident speakers, the platform surrounding the altar may be used for speeches.



5. PILLARS

Soaring neoclassical pillars run around the edge of the main space. We recommend using the pillars within the design of the event space and helping to manage guest flow. Why not position a bar, food station or seating area in between two columns? Add floral urns and uplighters to highlight the beautiful architecture and create a unique space to entertain your guests.



3. VESTRY & TOWER

The tower within the vestry is where the venue team office is located. The vestry offers access to the crypt via a staircase where the venue facilities are located. This includes the 2/4 WCs and the kitchen area your caterers will use to prepare food. A catering manager will be located in this area throughout food service to ensure a seamless experience for guests who need to use the facilities while food is leaving the kitchen.



6. COURTYARD

Located behind the church is a private courtyard which was designed by Lanning Roper in the late 1970s. Weather permitting, the courtyard offers a tranquil garden oasis in the centre of London for summer drinks receptions and pre dinner drinks. The courtyard even has its own private entrance, allowing you to keep the main church space as a surprise for guests when welcomed into dinner.



7. THE ORGAN

The organ is available to use during exclusive venue hire, the church team will be able to recommend and book an organist on your behalf who has experience and is familiar with performing at St Stephen Walbrook.



8. PIANO

St Stephen Walbrook frequently hosts concerts and recitals and has a grand piano located close to the pulpit, that can be used for exclusive hire events.




9. PEWS

Curved wooden pews surround Henry Moore's altar and offer seating for up to 270 guests. The pews can be removed for dinner and receptions to allow space for furniture and guests to mingle.




